The Center for Nursing Excellence can help you become a Nationally Certified Nurse.

REGISTERED NURSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING INCENTIVES NOW THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2026.

Benefits in Achieving National Certification:

- Up to 4 hours paid education time on the day of the exam
- One-time reimbursement of the certification exam fee regardless of pass or fail (*A 6-month service obligation is required.*)
- Pay increase of \$.75/hour that begins as soon as certification proof is provided and for as long as the certification is maintained.

Benefits for Nationally-Certified Nurses:

- Up to 8 hours of paid education time for CE-approved activity related to content applicable to maintain current certification.
- Annual Recognition on Certified Nurse's Day, March 19th.
