

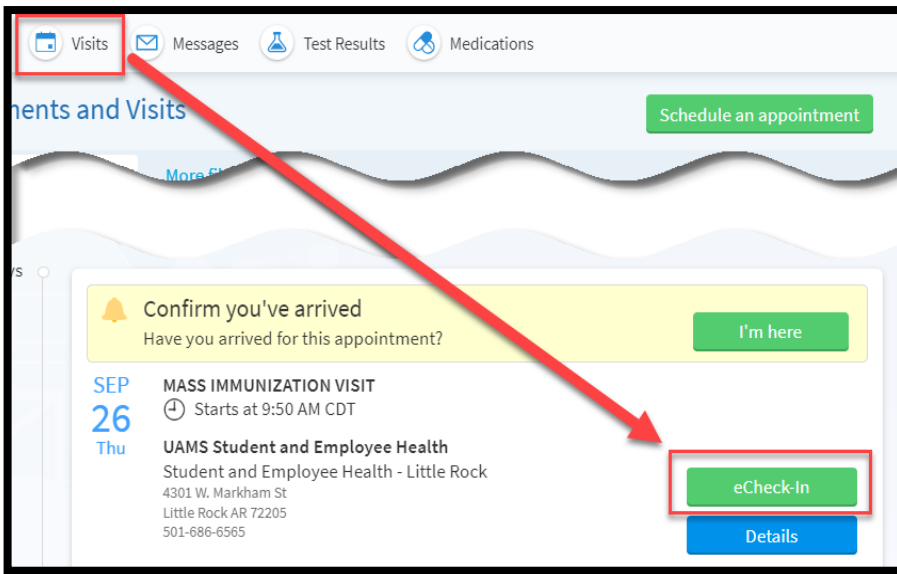


UAMS Student and Employees: Complete Consents Using eCheck-In Prior to Appointments in the Mass Immunization Clinic

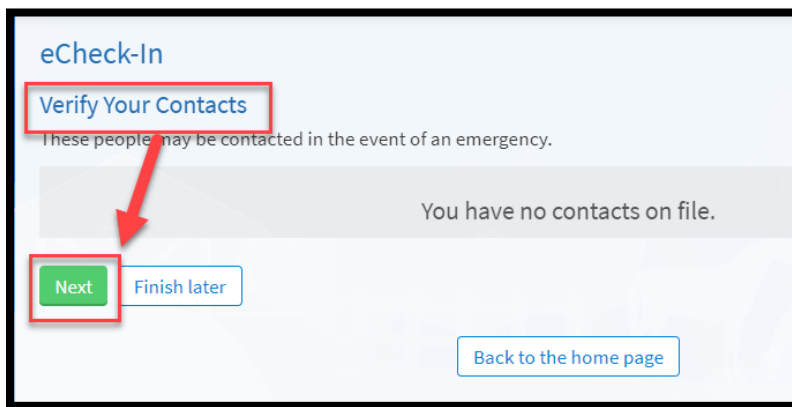


E-Check In/Complete Immunization Consent

1. A consent needs to be completed before you can have the immunization administered. This will be available to you in your MyChart account close to the time of your scheduled appointment.
2. In the **Visits** Menu, find the appointment then click **eCheck-In** as shown.



3. In the **Verify Your Contacts** screen, click, **Next**.



4. Complete the consent questions. Click **Continue** after all questions are answered.

Use of the inactivated influenza vaccine is the single most important measure in preventing and attenuating influenza infection. This vaccine is preservative free and contains noninfectious killed viruses and cannot cause influenza. Coincidental respiratory disease unrelated to influenza vaccination can occur. Vaccines used in recent years have not been associated with frequent reactions. Less than one third of vaccines have a local redness or induration for 1 or 2 days at the site of the injection. Systemic or febrile reactions are rare. Pregnant or breastfeeding women can get inactivated seasonal Flu vaccine.
